Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

QUALITY ASSURANCE

- 1. Work for "Setting up of Microbiological Section and Installation of Equipment on Turnkey Basis" is under process for the following laboratories: Aurangabad, Jaipur, Mysore, Thiruvananthapuram, Bengaluru, Belagavi, Bhubaneshwar, Vadodara, Patna, Bhopal, Solan, Varanasi, Ranchi, Singtam, Rudrapur, Agartala and Bhuj.
- 2. The certificates of 6th Junior Analyst Examination 2023 were issued to 177 qualified candidates recommended by the Food Analyst Examination Board."

TICD-IMPORT

Agreement For Recognition Of Official Control Exercised By Bhutan Food And Drug Authority (Bfda), Ministry Of Health, Royal Government Of Bhutan By Food Safety And Standards Authority Of India (Fssai), Ministry Of Health And Family Welfare, Government Of India.

An Agreement is signed between FSSAI, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and Bhutan Food and Drug Authority (BFDA), Ministry of Health Royal Govt of Bhutan, at Thimphu on 21 March, 2024. The signatory for the above said Agreement were Mr. SudhakarDalela, Ambassador of India to Bhutan (from India side) and Mr. Pemba Wangchuk, Secretary, Ministry of Health, Royal Government of Bhutan (Bhutan side).

This Agreement aims to recognize the official control exercised by BFDA on food business operators (FBO's) as equivalent to FSSAI's requirement for export of food products to India; ensuring that food and agricultural/livestock products exported from Bhutan to India are safe, wholesome and meet FSSAI's requirements; reducing duplication in the inspection of products notified under FSSAI's import inspection scheme from time to time; to enhance the technical cooperation in the areas and activities that fall within the scope of their activities; and to establish a workable mechanism between BFDA and FSSAI; to develop, cooperate and facilitate the trade.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

A. Food Safety Compliance System (FoSCoS):

- 1.) **Online Adjudication**: Previously the online adjudication process was in offline mode through paper work. Now the same process is online through FoSCoS application.
- 2.) **FOSTAC certificate authentication**: Provision for Validation of FoSTac certification on

Foscos portal during submission of application by FBOs.

B. Food Safety Training and Certification (FOSTAC):

- 1.) Provision for old FOSTAC users whose training certificates were expired can opt for refresher training in new FOSTAC application. More than 6 lakh trainees are eligible for refresher training.
- 2.) Provision to verify trainer: Photograph upload provision is provided to trainer which will reflect in admit card of every trainee corresponding to respective training for authentication & verification of trainer.
- 3.) Analytics dashboard: A comprehensive dashboard for all training related insights with visuals, trends & reports.
