In Future, training of regulatory staff will be managed through an online portal FOSREST (Food Safety Regulatory Staff Training)

About Induction Training

Induction Training has been structured for newly recruited officers. Newly recruited food safety officers will undergo the induction training as specified by the food authority. Total duration of induction training is of 40 days, which is divided into three phase:-

- Foundation Phase: - The foundation phase is online.
- Learning Phase: - Learning Phase will be at classroom.
- Application Phase: - Application Phase will be on job.
